

Preliminary Operating Statistics

For 1st Quarter of 2013



TAA posted a load factor of 87%, maintaining at the same level as the same period of prior year. The airline carried about 2.6 million passengers during the period, achieving 20% growth year-on-year which was in consistence with the capacity growth. TAA increased frequencies in domestic destinations such as Chiang Mai, Hat Yai, Krabi and Nakhon Si Thammarat to cater the increasing travel demand during high season. TAA added 1 aircraft this quarter, having a total fleet of 28 aircraft at the end of the period.
